

The European Union's GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) comes into force in the UK on 25th May 2018. This communication is intended to inform you as to what information The Munro Society (TMS) holds about you, why it is needed, what that information is used for and how it is protected.

- **When you register as a member of The Munro Society or renew your membership TMS asks you for your contact details - i.e. name, address, e-mail address and telephone number.**
- **If you do not provide TMS with this information it cannot effectively provide you with its membership services.**
- **TMS uses the information held for the purposes of confirmation of your membership at time of joining, annual renewal of your membership, distribution of newsletters, journals and other publications and notification of events including meets, AGMs and annual dinners. TMS will not use your personal information for any purpose other than those indicated above and will not pass your information to other parties without your permission.**
- **Your personal information is held by the Honorary Secretary and Honorary Treasurer as an electronic record on password protected PCs and is accessed only by them and by the President and Vice President and only for the purposes set out above.**
- **TMS will only keep your personal information for as long as necessary to provide you with membership services. TMS will delete your personal information when you have not renewed your membership.**
- **Should your personal information change there is an obligation on you to advise the Honorary Secretary or Honorary Treasurer of the change.**
- **TMS also requests, from time to time, information to maintain a "Member's Summary Climbing Record". Provision of this information is entirely voluntary and does not affect membership. This information is maintained by the Society's Archivist on a password protected PC and is only available to other members in summary form. As this information forms part of The Society's archive if you do not wish it to be retained on leaving The Society you should notify the Honorary Secretary accordingly.**
